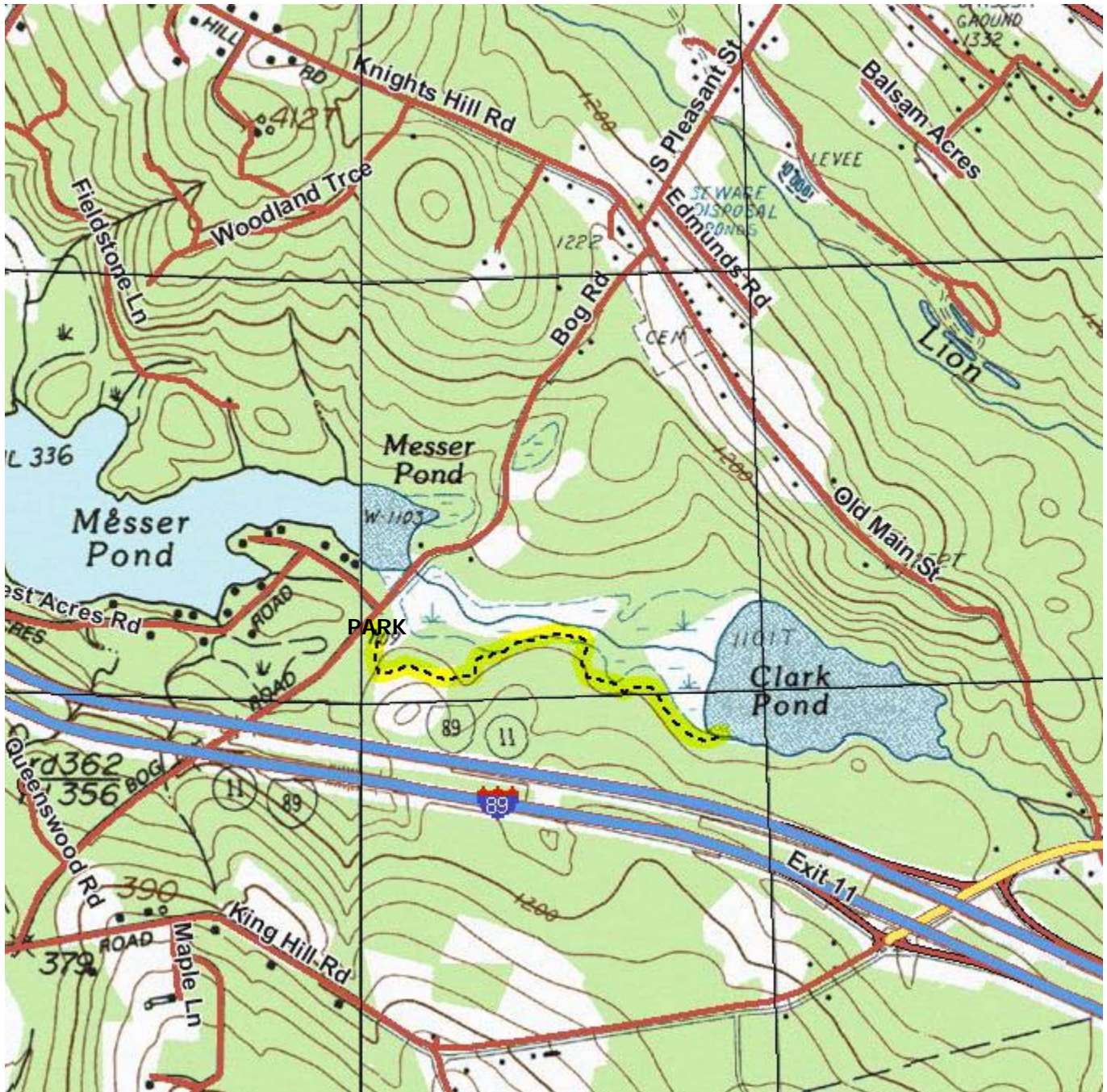


Clark Pond Trail, Bog Road, New London



The 91.41 acres on the west end of Clark Pond located between Bog Road and Clark Pond is owned by the Town of New London. The Town has placed a conservation easement on the land which is held by the Ausbon Sargent Land Preservation Trust. This easement protects to the frontage along Bog Brook and Clark Pond and provides public access with its well marked trail for foot traffic built and maintained by the New London Conservation Commission.

Trail details: The trail is easy (flat) with numerous recently built bridges over brooks and low spots on the trail. Currently there is one 3/4 mile trail to a view on Clark Pond. A second southerly trail is being created so that in the future there will be loop hike in and out.

Driving directions: From Main Street of New London take South Pleasant Street to the 3 way stop. Turn left onto to Old Main Street and then immediately turn right on Bog Road. Follow Bog Road for .8 of a mile just past Messer Pond on your right. Parking for the trail is well marked with a sign and gate on the east side of Bog Road—diagonally across from Forest Acres Road.
